



Area 5 Youth Scholarship
sponsored by ASPC/AMHR Club of North Texas



This award is open to All Youth in Area 5.
It is NOT restricted to ASPC/AMHR Club of North Texas Members.

History

This scholarship was initially set up with funds left over from the 2000 National Convention in which the ASPC/AMHR Club of N. Texas hosted. The first scholarship application was accepted in 2002 and the recipient received their award in the spring of 2003. The second scholarship award was presented in 2004. Since the initial money came from proceeds of the hosting of the 2000 National Convention and there were no established means to replenish the fund, the Club accepts donations for the scholarship fund.

Guidelines

- Applicants:
 1. Must permanently reside within the boundaries of Area 5.
 2. Age of applicant must be between the ages of 17 and 21 years.
 3. Be a member in good standing with ASPC/AMHR.
 4. Enrolled in a University, Jr. College, Community College or Trade School.
- It is desired but not required for the applicant to have a major or minor in a field of study that will directly or indirectly apply to the equine/agriculture industry.
- An application must be filed with the ASPC/AMHR Club of N. Texas' secretary by October 1 of current year. Contact Club secretary for an application.
- Applications will be reviewed by the Board of Directors for the Club of N. TX.
- Once the Board has chosen a recipient, they will continue to review the applications for an alternate recipient.
- The Board will present their choice and an alternate to the General Membership of the ASPC/AMHR Club of North Texas at the annual "Election" meeting in November.
- The General Membership will then vote to accept the Board's first recommendation. If the General Membership denies the Board's first choice, then the Board will present the alternate and the General Membership will then vote again.
- Once the General Membership votes in favor of the Board's recommendation, an announcement will be made as to who is going to receive the scholarship and the recipient will be notified, if they are not in attendance at the meeting.
- The Treasurer of the Club will finalize the scholarship award by requesting verification of enrollment into a continuing education program as earlier described. Once the recipient complies with this request, the Treasurer of the Club will issue the Scholarship Money for dispersal.
- A recipient can only accept this scholarship once.
